



# USING VDOWNLOADER



Are you ever worried about using media during a presentation because it will not be fast enough? Maybe you worry about a network outage. Vdownloader, a free application, available at <http://www.vdownloader.es/> can alleviate you of all your worries.

VDownloader is a video download program that lets you download videos from Google, YouTube and other video websites. With Vdownloader you are not limited to downloading to particular filetype and you do not have to embed the video.

Please read the Practical and Legal Considerations at the end to determine if the video can be used in a public viewing setting or may be downloaded.

## Downloading & Installing Vdownloader

1. To download Vdownloader to your computer, open a desired web browser. Enter the following address into the browser's web address field: <http://www.vdownloader.es/download.html>
2. Click on the Download Vdownloader icon (shown below).

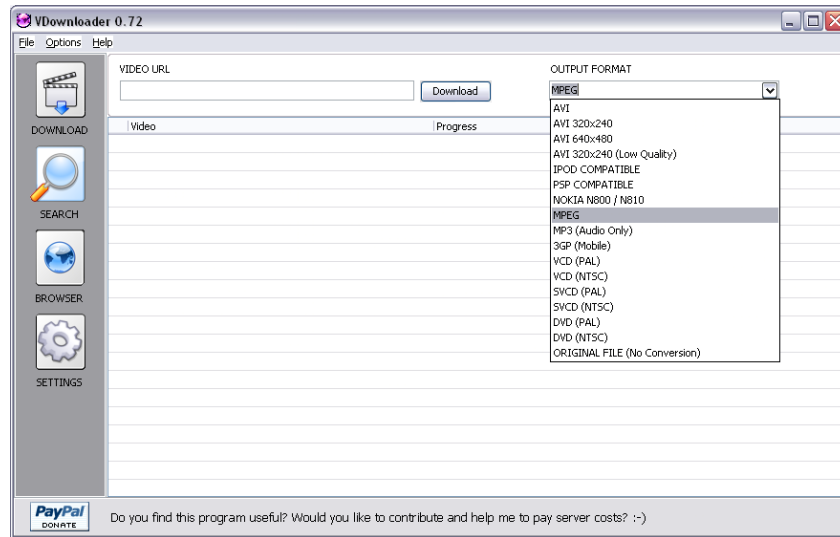


3. A pop-up File Download window will display. Click on the Save button and navigate your computer to a desired file location. Again, Click the Save button.
4. The file will begin downloading to the desired file location. Once the download is complete, navigate your computer to the saved file location.
5. Click on the file and extract the file.
6. A vdownloader file should be visible. Click the file folder and then the vdownloader.exe to launch the application.



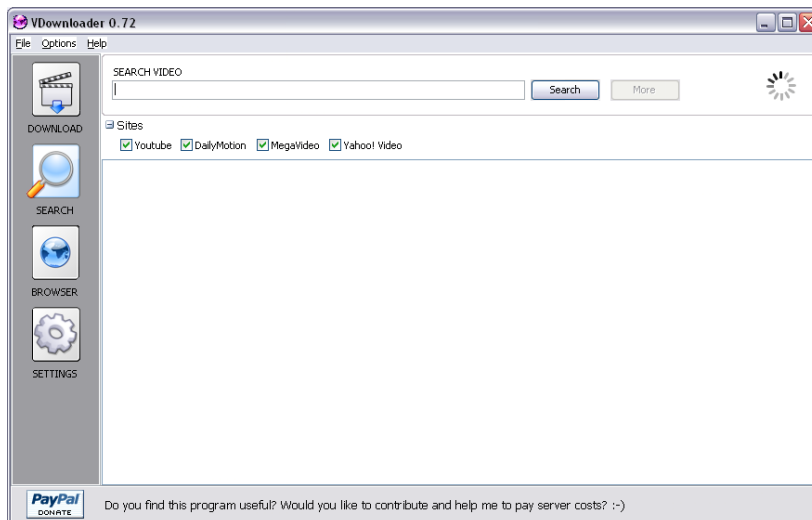
## Changing the Download settings

1. In order to select the Output Format, click the Download button and select the Output format from the drop-down menu.

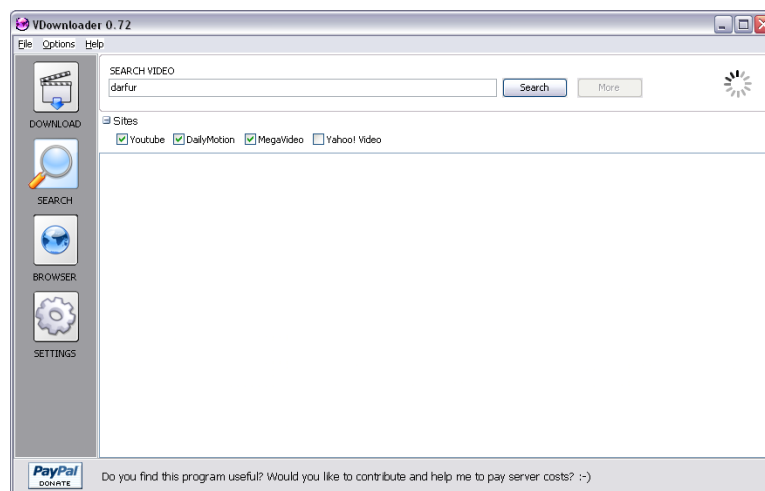


## Using Vdownloader

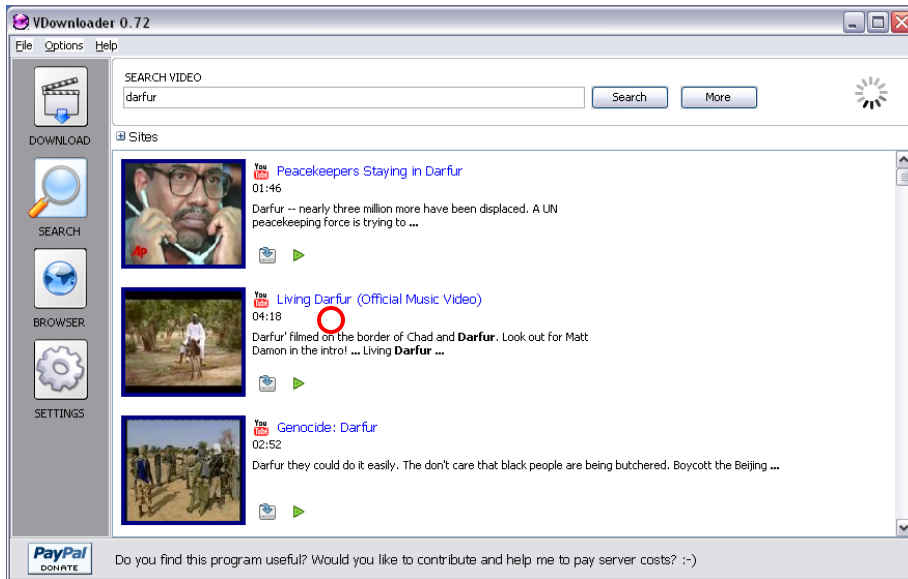
1. While in the Vdownloader application window, click on the Search icon.



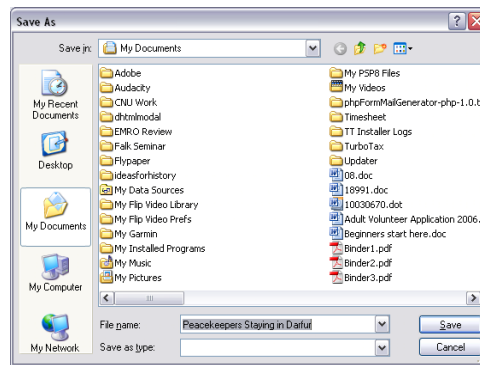
2. In the Search Video field, enter your desired search terms. Select or deselect the desired sites.



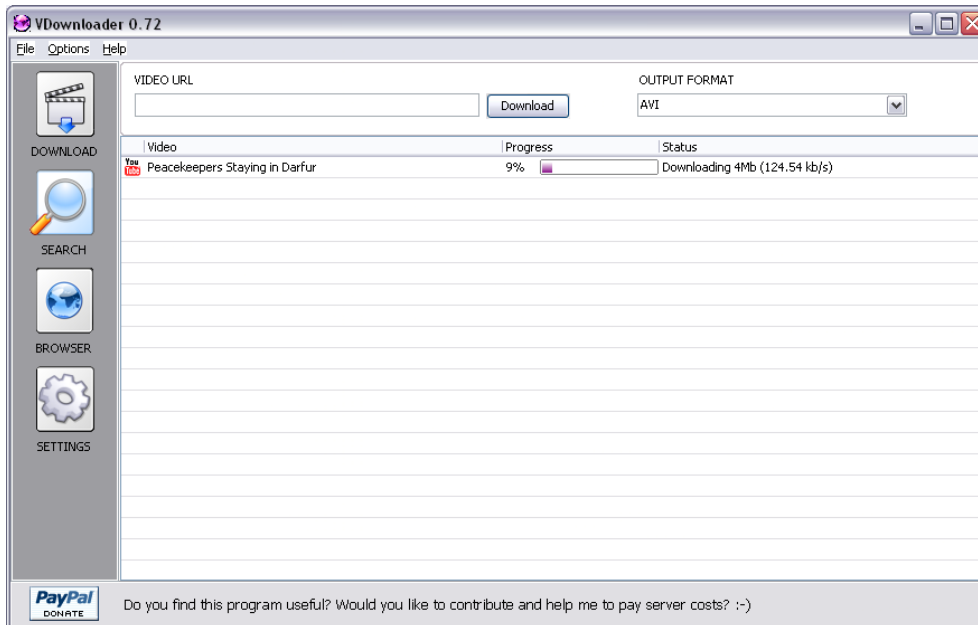
3. Once the search is complete, preview the results by pressing the play button.
4. After you have found a desired media item, press the download button (circled below).



5. The Save As dialog box will display. Navigate to the desired Save in Location and Type in the desired File Name. Click Save.



6. The video will begin downloading to your computer.



7. Once the file has downloaded, you should be able to successfully open and play the video file.
